**Rule #17**

**Each feeder calf will get  $\frac{1}{3}$  of a panel space. Each Steer or Heifer over a year old will get  $\frac{1}{2}$  of a panel.**

How much space each family gets for tack

**Each family will get  $\frac{1}{2}$  of a panel of tack space.**

Outside stalling- needs assigned

**Outside chute/tent space on the north side of the Beef barn will be on a first come basis.**

**Each family will be limited to 10ft of space.**

1 kid, 1 helper in the make-up ring

**Each 4-H member is limited to one family member/helper allowed in the make up arena.**

Showmanship to be moved to Tuesday following the breeding show

**Need to add to rules and by-laws**

There needs to be representation from each club that is on the beef committee.

**Beef Committee Officers consist of at least 1 advisor from each club that is on the Beef Committee.**
