

**EQUINE PRINCE AND PRINCESS
CONTEST RULES**

1. Contestants should be 8-13 years of age as of January 1st, current year.
2. Contestants must be a member of a junior fair organization and be exhibiting an equine project in the current year.
3. The application is due May 15, to the secretary's office under the grandstand on the fairgrounds, attention junior fair coordinator.
4. Interviews will be scheduled every 20 minutes with each interview lasting 15 minutes. Contestants will be contacted with their interview time. Interviews will be held the first Tuesday of June from 4:30-7:30 p.m. depending on amount of applicants.
5. Results will be announced at noon during the PAS show.
6. The prince and princess should maintain the dress and poise of their positions during the entire fair. The prince and princess may not win more than one time. Runner-ups may apply again.
