- 1. Callie asked when the fair passes would be done. (Betsy)
- 2. Callie wanted to remind us of the Jr. Fair Assistant Program. She mentioned if any youth wanted to help just to let the Jr. Fair Board know. She pointed out that she would be gone before the fair and it's Allsion and Summer's first year. The assistants can do anything but vote.
- 3. Emily Hartman addressed the board in regards to the Equine 4H Scholarship. She passed out the guidelines to apply for the scholarship. The question arose for those that were heading off to college and wouldn't be able to participate in the fair their last year of 4H. She is asking for this to be changed and/or be re-worded. The committee agreed to change it to allow for those to apply who are eligible to be in good standing and who have shown the previous years. The committee agreed to make the change for this 2025 year. Mary made a motion to change the wording and Madison seconded the motion. Motion Passed.
- 4. Royalty is going to change back to allowing the youth to run every other year. (Boys- had a low turnout)

New Business

- 1. Gravel- Fair board asked that we pay for the gravel, however, were hoping we can get it donated. Foreman's \$23.95 a ton and recommended 6 tons. She also reached out to Pepcon. Mary Neill moved to pay for the gravel and Madison Werner seconded the motion.
- 2. Went over Judge's Notes
- a. Bareback classes are judged as equitation or horsemanship classes and it's up to the judge if they want to provide a pattern or rail work
 - b. Draft classes are walk/trot only
 - c. General walk/trot classes- up to the judge if they want to provide a pattern or rail work.
 - d. Addressed whether the judge should DQ them or place them at the bottom of the class
- 3. Each club takes a day and needs to provide someone to sing the National Anthem. (or ask for list of those who would be interested)
- 4. Don't forget about the "Drain the Pool" fundraiser for the arena. (Greenville Pool) July 22 from 6-8pm. Silent Auction and 50/50 available. If anyone wants to bring bake goods to sell.
