- Only 2 standing fans per animal, which must be suspended. No standing fans allowed in the barn. NO screws, nails, or painting permitted on the middle divider wall. Porta-cools are permitted.

Rule #17 - Outside chute/tent space on the north side of the Beef barn will be on a first come basis. Each family will be limited to 10ft of space.

Rule #29 Each showman is permitted to have 1 additional person in the make-up arena.

-All junior Fair exhibitors with market projects are eligible for the weight gain contest. The weight gain contest will be divided into two classes- heavy weights and light weights. Classes to be determined by averaging the starting weights and dividing by animal above. Market steers and Market heifers will be awarded separately.
