Daxton Harter read the treasurer report the starting balance was \$1,659.91 there was 21 cents for interest added for an ending balance of \$1,660.12. Katelynne motioned to approve the agenda Grace seconded it. The motion passed.

Old business

New business

Each committee can decide if they would like to make an application for their assistants

The chairman needs to make a committee to change the constitution to allow more members per department.

Danica motioned to create a committee to change an amendment Wesley 2nd it motion passed.

ShoWorks- Betsy asked the board to pay half of her and Alantas ShoWorks training this comes out to \$900 from donation from last year and will also be doing trashbash to raise money Grace motioned to give them the money Wesley 2nd it. Motion passed.

Stock the trailer- start to think about it and local foodbanks prefer canned items over cases of water.

Poultry leg bands- poultry is wondering if they can put leg bands on before the fair to save time. This is going to the poultry department to start this idea.

Hearts of Darke- usually takes place Monday @ 2 pm (Betsy is checking with the sheep committee before this is finalized) needs members to help run this event. Grace, Lexie, Merideth and Julia volunteered.

Betsy- remember to attend your committee meetings. Would like to move the April work day she will send out dates to change it too.

Carrie Dehlinger(sheep) joined the junior fair board Wesley made a motion to accept this member and Danica 2nd it. Motion Passed.

Heidi - would like to move the pageant to June 19-20 with the interviews on the 19th and the pageant on the 20th because Farm Power of the Past will be going on. They will use the community building because dogs will be at state fair. Katelynne motioned to approve these changes and Grace 2nd it and the motion passed.

Jayden reminded everyone to read through the folders.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:13 Grace motioned it and Wesley 2nd it motion passed.
