- 1. Contestants should be 14-18 years of age as of January 1st of the current year.
- 2. Contestants must be a member of a 4-H horse club or a FFA chapter who is involved in the horse program.
- 3. Contestants must have shown the prior year and current year at the Darke County Jr. Fair Horse Show.
- 4. The king and queen will each have one attendant.
- 5. The application is due June 1 at the Senior Fairboard Office.
- 6. The interview will be scheduled every 20 minutes with interviews lasting a maximum of 15 minutes. You will be called with an interview time. Interviews will be the first Tuesday of June.
- 7. The results will be announced at the PAS Show at Noon.
- 8. The king and queen should maintain the dress and poise of his or her position during the entire time of the fair. The King and/or Queen may not Win more than once. Runner-up may apply again.
- 9. If you can't attend Skillathon, you can't apply.
